Tuition Deposit Information

What you need to know:

All students must pay a \$50 tuition deposit by June 30, 2017 to hold their Fall 2017 schedule of classes at the college. If you do not pay your deposit by the deadline, your schedule will be dropped and your seats will become available to other students.

Matriculated Students:

As an alternative to paying the \$50 deposit, you can hold your schedule by filing a 2017-2018 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) with Hudson Valley's school code (002868) by June 16, 2017. If you do not begin the financial aid application process by the deadline, you must pay the tuition deposit.

Payment:

Your deposit can be made on Hudson Valley WIREd, in-person, by mail using the form below, or over the telephone with a credit card.

Program Specific Tuition Deposits:

If your acceptance letter indicates that a tuition deposit is required to reserve your seat in a program, your tuition deposit deadline may be earlier and you cannot satisfy the requirement by completing a FAFSA. Please contact the Admissions Office for specific information.

Non-refundable:

The tuition deposit is a non-refundable payment. If you are unsure as to whether you will attend Hudson Valley, there is no rush to make payment. Once you have considered your options, if you decide Hudson Valley is the right fit for you, payment can be made to the Cashier's Office by the deadline.
