Welcome to TechSmith Relay! Below you will find instructions on how to access your organization's TechSmith Relay site and begin creating videos.


What is Relay?

Relay gives you an easy way to create and store video content. You have access to:

- An online library where you can store as many videos as you'd like.
- A web-based recorder to easily create new videos of yourself and your screen.
- A simple way to share these videos.


Step 1: Login

- Go to your Relay site: https://hvcc.techsmithrelay.com/.
- Click 'Sign In'. Login using your existing HVCC credentials.



Step 2: Record a video!

- You should now be in your personal Relay library.
- Click the Launch Capture button to create a NEW video.






*Note: you may have to download the recorder the first time you use it.

 - o Upload a video to your Blackboard course and configure.
