Procedures:	<u>Pesticide containers:</u> empty pesticide containers must be cleaned before disposal with triple rinsing. Rinse water will be applied to fields. Containers with ready to use pesticides (already diluted) can be disposed of after draining for at least 30 seconds. All hazard warning labels should be removed or defaced, the container sealed to prevent leakage, and put in the regular trash.
	<u>Chemical containers</u> : empty chemical containers must be rinsed once before disposal, all hazard warning labels removed or defaced and the container sealed to prevent leakage. Rinse water is applied to fields, empty container is disposed in regular trash.
	Other liquid waste: drain all liquids from container and use and dispose of container in regular trash
	<u>Aerosol spray cans</u> : commercially available aerosol cans with products such as WD-40, wasp and bee killer and paints may be disposed of into the general trash or scrap metal recycling container upon complete utilization of the can contents. If the can is no longer used and it still contains product, the product will be brought back to the contractor's home office.
