TITLE:	SLOP SINK USAGE AT THE JBS
Regulatory Citation:	Rensselaer County Sewer District Number 1 Regulations
Applicability:	The rinsing of any containers or disposal of their contents into the slop sink. Routine hand washing is allowed.
Purpose:	To ensure that sewer discharges do not violate the County sewer regulations or damage/clog receiving pipes
Person or Department Responsible:	Supervisor, Brickman Group Director of Environmental Health & Safety (EHS)
Schedule:	As needed
Procedure:	<ul> <li>The disposal of chemicals to the slop sink is prohibited. Rinsing of empty containers is allowable, but disposal of chemicals from their container by dumping in the sink is not allowed, but is addressed in JBS BMP#7. Discharge of materials that can clog drains is also prohibited, such as food grease and other wastes which are to be disposed of in drums and dumpsters, respectively. In addition, RCSD prohibits:</li> <li>Discharges that by their nature cause fire or interferences at the POTW;</li> <li>Discharges at such a temp that would prohibit biological activity; and</li> <li>Discharges with a pH of less then 5.5 or above 9.5.</li> </ul> If chemicals, pesticides or a condition noted above has been or is suspect to have been discharged to the sanitary sewer then the Director of Environmental, Health and Safety must be contacted immediately.
