Federal regulations prohibit a student from receiving federal student aid (Pell Grant, SEOG, student loans and work-study) if they have attempted more than 150% of their degree requirements. For example, if 60 credit hours are required to graduate in a degree program, a student becomes ineligible for federal student aid after the semester in which they attempt the 90th credit hour (60 x 150%=90).
