Directions to the Campus:

FROM NORTH - Take Exit 7 from the Northway (I-87). Follow Rte. 7 East approximately 1.5 miles to I-787 South. Take I-787 South to Rte. 378 East. Continue on 378 over bridge to Rte. 4. Bear right to Rte. 4 South and continue for one mile to the Hudson Valley campus on the left.

FROM SOUTH - Take Exit 23 off I-87 (NYS Thruway). Follow I-787 North 6 miles to the exit for Rte. 378 East. Take Rte. 378 over bridge to Rte. 4. Bear right to Rte. 4 South. Continue one mile to the Hudson Valley campus on the left.

FROM EAST - Take Exit B-1 of the Massachusetts Turnpike. Follow I-90 approximately 9 miles to Exit 8 (Defreestville). Turn left off ramp to Route 4 North. Continue for five miles. Hudson Valley is on the right.

FROM WEST - Take Exit 24 off I-90 (NYS Thruway), continue on I-90 East 6 miles to I-787 North (Troy). Follow I-787 North 2.2 miles to the exit for Rte. 378 East. Take Rte 378 over the bridge to Rte. 4. Bear right to Rte. 4 South and continue one mile to the Hudson Valley campus, on the left.

1. NYS Certification Course: Local Infiltration Anesthesia and Nitrous Oxide Analgesia

The New York State Board of Regents established requirements for licensed dental hygienists to obtain a restricted certificate to administer local infiltration anesthesia and nitrous oxide analgesia in the practice of dental hygiene under the personal supervision of a licensed dentist. Upon the successful completion of this course, the dental hygienist will be able to apply for certification through the New York State Education Department. 35 credit (contact) hours will be awarded at the completion of this course.

The required 45 hours are divided into 30 hours of Web-enhanced and classroom instruction (didactic component) and 15 hours of clinical experiences. The Web-enhanced course is designed for the hygienist who prefers independent learning. Study guides for each textbook, course schedules and requirements will be available online. Lecture materials for specific topic areas will be provided in the format of PowerPoint presentations. Instructors will respond to short questions via email. Additional discussion time will be allotted on campus for clarification of topics, as needed.

If you are pregnant, have uncontrolled high blood pressure or are otherwise unable or unwilling to be a patient, please do not register for this course. Participants who do not meet clinical competency for local anesthesia and nitrous analgesia experiences will not be permitted to challenge the written certification exam and will be required to re-take the entire course at

their own expense. Participants who have met all clinical competencies but do not meet the 70 percent competency on the written certification exam will be allowed to re-challenge the exam at a future date.

Prerequisites: In order to attend this course, participants are required to show proof of current CPR/BLS certification for health care professionals. Online CPR/BLS courses are acceptable if a hands-on skill portion is part of the certification. Proof of current New York Dental Hygiene licensure and registration is required prior to the initial class meeting. All participants are required to take and record blood pressure and follow the latest infection control standards. An email address is required at time of registration.

Attendance is required at all classes (didactic and clinical).

2. Review Course: Local Infiltration Anesthesia

This course will review and refresh the knowledge and skills required for safe and effective administration of local infiltration anesthesia. Topics reviewed include neuroanatomy, pharmacology of local anesthetics, anatomical landmarks for injection sites, armamentarium and injection technique.

All participants will deliver and receive local anesthesia. This is web-enhanced with PowerPoint presentations and study guides available online.

This course is a review and is not intended to satisfy New York State's Restricted Certificate to administer local infiltration anesthesia.

The required 10 hours are divided into three hours of web-enhanced review, and seven hours of clinical instruction. 10 CEUs will be awarded for completion of this course. If you are pregnant, have uncontrolled high blood pressure or are otherwise unable or unwilling to be a patient, please do not register for this course.
